Dept of Environmental Conservation

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) is proposing new air quality regulations in Title 18. 50 and an air quality plan (state implementation plan, or SIP) for the Fairbanks North Star Borough (FNSB) in order to comply with provisions of the federal Clean Air Act. Included are an air quality plan for the use of wood stoves and solid fuel heating devices, outdoor open burning, visible emissions (opacity), commercial wood selling, and the grand fathering of wood stoves from emission standards. The proposal would also add clarifying language regarding a local government's powers or obligations, establish federally required air episode levels and revise solid fuel-fired heating device visible emission regulations statewide.

The Alaska Board of Fisheries (board) proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 5 related to registration and reporting requirements for sport fishing services and sport fishing guides and correcting errors and omissions dealing with certain finfish and shellfish fisheries. These proposals also include subsistence and commercial fishing descriptions and effect Ivanof Bay, Uyak Bay, Cape Igvak, Jonah Bay, the Wally Noerenberg (Esther Island) Hatchery Management Plan, the Silver Bay (Medvejie Creek Hatchery) Salmon Management Plan commercial groundfish fishing with pots in the Prince William Sound Area, winter boundary lines in Ocean Cape, and blue crab fisheries and various state wide commercial fisheries.
